



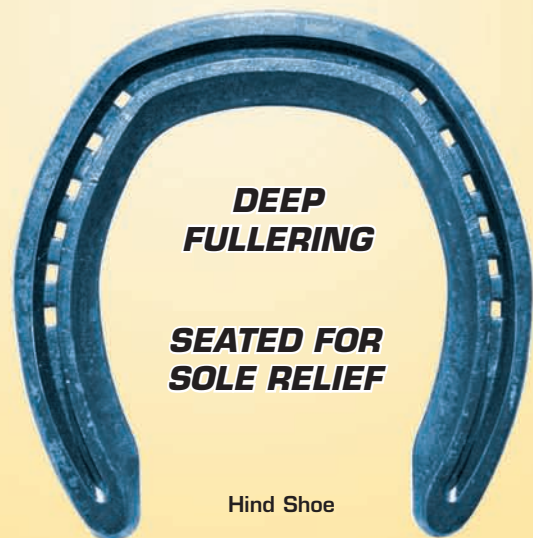

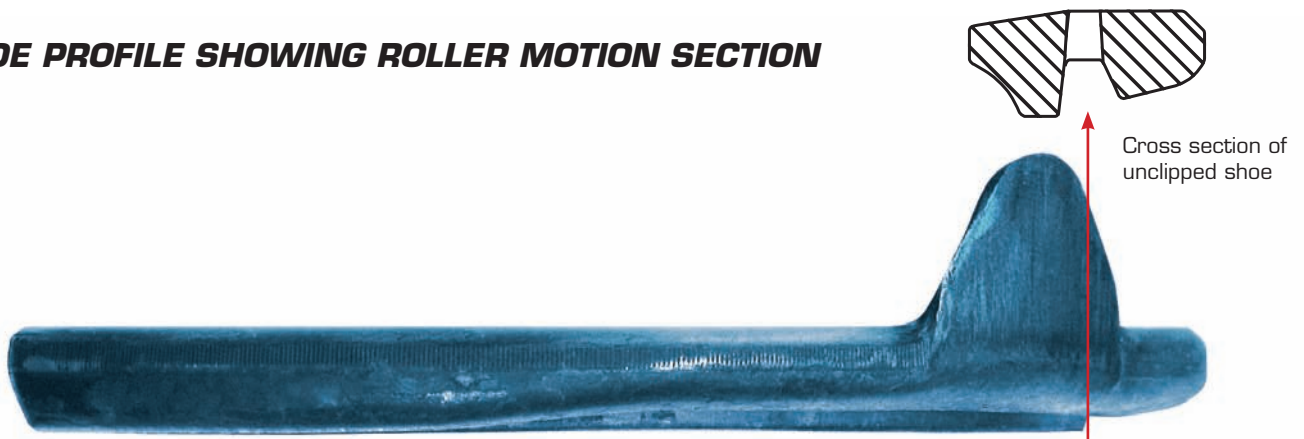

Because of the unique section these shoes provide some relief to the Medio-lateral strain on the collateral ligaments of the interphalangeal joints.

NOTES FOR FARRIERS: INFORMATION

We would like you to get the very best out of these shoes and offer the following comments that have come from a number of farriers who have used the shoes on test.

We feel that these comments would be particularly useful to students and apprentices using the shoes for the first time:

- It is recommended on the first few horses you apply Vulcan shoes to, that you trim and dress the feet to your requirements, before heating the shoes, offer them up to each hoof to check the size and consider how you wish to fit them. Vulcan "RM" has a basic shape, which should be easy for you to alter to your requirements on a properly trimmed hoof.
- We recommend students start by positioning, fitting and altering the toe to what is required for that individual horses hoof, limb and your shoeing plan, fit the quarters of the shoe to correspond with the hoof and your plan, then finally shape the heels to your desired fit. Vulcan Shoes have fairly coarsely punched nail holes, intended for good walled horses. Care should be taken to ensure during fitting that the nail holes are situated in the correct position in relation to the white line of the horses hoof for obvious reasons.
- The shoes are "ready boxed" and this needs to be taken into consideration when you are fitting and shaping the shoes. You will need to decide if you are fitting the boxing under the hoof or outside the hoof wall giving careful consideration to nail position in the hoof and entry in the white line area.
